

## EAA Chapter 613 Poker Run 2017



### Ground Rules

1. This Poker "Run" has no prize for speed.
2. One contestant per airplane.
3. The winning hand is determined by standard five card poker hand rankings.
4. Contestants need to fly to at least one of the participating airports and pick up a card. The more participating airports visited prior to proceeding to KFSO, the better the chance of a winning hand.
  - a. Participating airports are: KCDA, KMVL, KMPV, KRUT, KFSO.
  - b. Contestants can fly to the airports in any order prior to proceeding to KFSO.
  - c. Contestants need to arrive in KFSO by 1300 hrs.
  - d. Two additional cards can be obtained by exercising accurate fuel management and fueling up at KFSO.
5. All envelopes are to remain closed and only opened in front of the organizers in KFSO.
6. For logistics, the Poker Run will use multiple card decks. If a player ends up with any identical cards, a situation which never occurs in "real life" poker, the player will need to draw a new card.
7. The attached score sheet contains instructions which will be used to determine the winner(s).

### Fuel Management bonus cards

- a) Accurate fuel management will allow contestants to get two additional cards that may be used to build a better 5 card poker hand.
- b) The procedure is simply to state how much fuel will your airplane need to fill up the tanks at KFSO and top them off.
- c) The number of cards will be based on the difference between what was stated and the amount fueled compared to the fuel capacity of the airplane as follows:
  - Two cards if the difference is up to 5%.
  - One card if the difference is between 5.1% and 10%.
